The BLM did not issue an exploration permit because they didn't think they needed to. The people from White Oak are just going to break the seals and go in to look at the condition of the mine and equipment. They may have to get the fan going. They're having to blast the seals, but, since it's underground, that's under the jurisdiction of MSHA.

I agree they don't need an exploration permit. I would have preferred written notification, and I think they should do that if there's going to be much activity. However, they've given us verbal notice, and I think that's adequate for now. If the activity continues, they may need to notify us they're no longer in temporary cessation.
