PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits notice to remove the sediment traps along the DesBeeDove (DBD) sediment pond access road.


This action reflects the recent bond release/turnover of the DBD haulroad to Emery County. The said sediment traps treat the runoff from the test plot area and steep slopes along the road. Energy West no longer has the responsibility to treat this runoff since it comes from outside the legal permit or disturbed area. All references to the sediment traps have been eliminated from the DBD MRP.
