8. Noncoal Waste

There were several pieces of corrugated steel that had blown off the edge of the warehouse pad. This is a very, very steep slope, and the operator has retrieved them.

There are several buckets of a mortar-type material that is being used to seal the portals. These buckets will need to be cleaned up.

15. Cessation of Operations

The company that broke some of the portal seals to do some exploration has resealed most of them. The Little Dove portal is not quite completely sealed, and the uppermost fan portal is not sealed at all. Because of several I-beams at the fan portal, it would be impossible for a person to enter the mine, but there was clearly some exhaust coming out of the mine.

Mr. Oakley indicated the operator may want to begin removing some equipment in preparation for reclamation. As long as this is done in accordance with the mining and reclamation plan, an amendment would not be necessary to begin this work, but the operator needs to notify the Division when it would begin since this may mean the mine is no longer in temporary cessation.
