Note: The purpose of this complete inspection was to tour the mine site and pump house area as the permitting and compliance responsibilities for this mine have been temporarily delegated to the undersigned.

1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

The permit was renewed on August 30, 2000 with one special condition; to begin the submittal of water quality data electronically beginning with the fourth quarter of 2000. The Division has not received a signed copy of the renewal as of September 6, 2000. Amendment #00A, received 5/18/2000, is pending. This amendment involves the reclamation of the pump house area.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS

According to Susan White during the previous complete inspection: "Disturbed area markers are the only method to determine the disturbed area. Many of the markers are missing. No map is found in the permit clearly showing the disturbed area." Susan is going to contact Dennis Oakley to resolve this issue.

7. COAL MINE WASTE/REFUSE PILES/IMPOUNDMENTS

Coal mine waste and non-coal waste have been placed against cut slopes and highwalls. Asphalt was included in the material placed against the material yard cut slope. The Forest Service stated in the May 11, 2000 during a site meeting that Forest land is not suitable for solid waste disposal. The Operator stated that no decision has been made on what to do with this material.

8. NONCOAL WASTE

According to Susan White during the previous complete inspection: "Non-coal waste was scattered throughout the site from demolition activities. This material must be placed as required by the permit. In particular are the items both within and outside the disturbed area at the base of the bath house slope." (See Figure 1: Non-Coal Waste From Demolition Activities). Susan is going to contact Dennis Oakley to resolve this issue.

21. BONDING AND INSURANCE

Bond No. 400JN6139 is held by St. Paul Fire and Marine Insurance Company in the amount of \$1,837,712. Associated Electric & Gas Insurance Services Limit provides general liability insurance. The policy is effective until 8/01/02.
