**Re: Amendment to Des-Bee-Dove Mines Permit, Appendix XIV (separate booklet)
Phase 1 Area Reclamation Plan: Beehive/Little Dove Mines, PacifiCorp, Des-Bee-Dove Mines, C/015/017, Emery County, Utah**

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits a separate appendix volume entitled "Appendix XIV Phase 1 Reclamation Plan". As stated in the plan, the historical use of the Phase 1 Area (Beehive & Little Dove Mines) pre-dates the passage of SMCRA. This area consists of a small mine pad/storage area and access roads. Two separate mines were developed in the Blind Canyon (upper) seam; Beehive and Little Dove. Each of the mines consisted of three separate portals. The Des-Bee-Dove Mines operated from the early 1900's until they were sealed according to Mine Safety Health Administration regulations in 1987. From 1987 through 1999 the mines remained in temporary cessation.

On February 26, 1997, PacifiCorp submitted a Notice of Intent to reclaim the Des-Bee-Dove Mine. In 1999 PacifiCorp initiated final reclamation in a multi-faceted approach. The following list outlines the projects completed to date and the scheduled for remaining areas:

Completed Projects

- ✓ Surface Facility Demolition Project: Initiated and completed in the fall of 1999.
- ✓ Maple Gulch Remote Portals: Final reclamation completed in July 2000.
- ✓ Pumphouse Area: Final Reclamation completed in the fall of 2000.

On-going Projects

- + Tipple Valley Fill Removal Project: Excavation initiated in March 2001, project scheduled to be completed by May 2001.
- + Phase 1 Reclamation: Final reclamation of the Beehive/Little Dove Mines portal pad and access roads will start on April 2, 2001, and is scheduled to be completed by May 15, 2001.


