1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

Two documents in the mine's copy of the permit have not been signed by the Division representative: Exhibit D - Stipulation to Revise the Reclamation Agreement (change of surety) and the Surety Bond. The Division's copies are signed.

3. TOPSOIL

The only coal mining and reclamation at this site since the last inspection has been excavation of several soil-test pits and trenches to identify possible topsoil or plant growth medium for reclamation. Bedrock was encountered at approximately five feet under the Beehive - Little Dove pad.

4B. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: SEDIMENT PONDS AND IMPOUNDMENTS

The sediment pond is still being decanted so it can either be cleaned or reclaimed.

4C. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES

Fresh straw bales have been installed at the outflow from the sedimentation-pond subsoil storage pile ASCA.

8. NONCOAL WASTE

Soil test pits and other excavation work has uncovered abundant non-coal waste. This will either be buried on site or hauled to a refuse disposal site as reclamation progresses.
