PURPOSE:

To observe the progress of Phase I reclamation.

OBSERVATIONS:

Photos taken during this field visit are located in O:015017.dbd/IMAGES/03182002. There were two trackhoes and a dozer working the site as well as a track mounted pneumatic hammer. Boulders were being moved from the slope in the vicinity of drainage #1. Soil was being pushed up and lifted up from drainage #3 location to form lifts between the drainages. Cement encountered in the vicinity of drainage #2 was being hammered. The rock ledge found in trench #1 had not yet been uncovered by soil removal. The soil stockpile was placed alongside the road out of the way of the construction activity. The stockpile is signed. A small amount of soil remains to be salvaged from above the binwall to the southeast of drainage #3.

RECOMMENDATIONS/CONCLUSIONS:

The trees growing on the slope in the vicinity of drainage #1 should be saved.
