RE: Amendment to Include Supplemental Volume, Legal and Financial Information, for the Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine, the Deer Creek Mine, Des Bee Dove Mine, and Trail Mountain Mine in Emery County, Utah.

Dear Mr. Haddock:

This in response to the Utah Division of Oil, Gas, & Mining's (UT-DOGM) June 10, 2003, request for a decision, under 30 CFR 944.30, whether the above subject permit revision constitutes a mining plan modification.

Mining plan approvals by the Secretary of the Interior are required under the Mineral Leasing Act of 1920, 30 U.S.C 181, *et seq.* before coal mining can occur on Federal lands. This letter serves to document OSM's determination whether or not a mining plan approval from the Secretary is required for the above permitting action.

OSM's review of the Application to Include a Supplemental Volume has determined that it proposes to create a single volume to contain all of the legal, financial, ownership and control, compliance history, right-of-entry, certificates of liability insurance, and other administrative information for the Cottonwood/Wilberg Mine, the Deer Creek Mine, the Des Bee Dove Mine, and Trail Mountain Mine, Utah State permits C/015/019, C/015/018, C/015/017, and C1015/009 respectively. Consolidation of this information, much of which is duplicative would facilitate easier updating.

Based on a review of the activities associated with the permit revision, OSM has determined that the proposal does not meet the requirements of 30 CFR § 746.11(a) and 746.18(d). Therefore, since no changes in the recovery of Federal coal is involved, the proposed permit revision does not constitute a mining plan action requiring Secretarial approval.

Please notify the applicant of our decision on this matter.

OSM's decision does not, however, relieve UT-DOGGM from coordinating the review and approval of the Application to Include a Supplemental Volume with other Federal agencies for compliance with other Federal regulations.
