Subject: Spring Planting at DesBeeDove Mine

Jerrianne,

As per your request, I am sending you an update of our intentions for planting at DesBeeDove Mine this spring.

I have secured 1500 bareroot Saskatoon Serviceberrys from Lone Peak nursery.
I have secured 1500 potted Curlleaf Mahogonys from Sun Mountain nursery.
I will have Sun Mountain nursery contract grow for us the Pinyon and Utah juniper.
I have secured 150 gallon sized Utah junipers from Wildlands nursery.

We are also planning to plant these same four species at our research farm to supplement plants that die off.

We hope to be planting by mid-April the 1500 serviceberry, the 1500 mahogany and the 150 junipers (to be planted in the Phase 1 area). The pinyon and junipers will be planted the fall of 2005.
