On August 24, 1984, a right-of-way (UTU-53809) was granted to Utah Power & Light for a sediment storage area (Des Bee Dove Mine) located on public lands. The right-of-way is located in Emery County, Utah, T. 17 S., R. 7 E., Sec 35. This right-of-way will expire on August 22, 2004, but is renewable.

If you wish to renew this grant, it will be necessary to contact this office before June 22, 2004. If you do not wish to renew the grant you are obligated by the terms of the grant to contact us 90 days prior to expiration to discuss reclamation procedures.

Permanent Sediment Storage Area, Des-Bee-Dove Mine  
Sedimentation Pond, Emery County, Utah**

Dear Ms. Hubert:

In our telephone conversation today, we discussed some of the various land and rights-of-way issues involved with the Des-Bee-Dove Mine sedimentation pond and the final disposition of these public lands. As mentioned, we have been conducting final reclamation on all of the disturbed lands associated with the entire Des-Bee-Dove Mine complex. The final phase of the reclamation process is to reclaim the sedimentation pond during this field season. As we conclude matters with this project, we also desire to formally abandon right-of-way grant no. U-53809 with your consent


This right-of-way was granted as a permanent sediment storage location in 1984 with the rights to stabilize the sediment in place and to be rehabilitated in accordance with the terms of the grant. The location of this permanent sediment storage area is also located within the Emery County Road easement (UTU-50148) for county road no. 412 which was assigned to Emery County by PacifiCorp (successor to Utah Power & Light Company) on or about June 11, 1998. In an effort to fulfill our obligation, we respectfully request your assistance to formally address this matter to enable us to relinquish the referenced right-of-way grant. See the attached 8½" x 11" drawings to acquaint yourself with the easement locations.



### Right-of-Way Relinquishment Accepted Details of Relinquishment

On June 1, 2004, PacifiCorp dba Interwest Mining Company filed a notice of relinquishment on right-of-way UTU-53809, which authorized a sediment storage area on public land in Emery County, described as follows:

Salt Lake Meridian  
T. 17 S., R. 7 E., section 35, E½NE¼NE¼NE¼.  
Containing 3.05 acres, more or less.

A field inspection conducted June 14, 2004, has confirmed that all the conditions of the subject right-of-way have been complied with. Rental was paid in full for the term of the grant which expired on August 22, 2004. BLM workload and mandated priorities have prevented the staff from completing the processing of your request until now, but this in no way penalizes the holder of the grant.

Relinquishment of the above-described parcel of public land is hereby accepted, effective August 22, 2004. Authority for such action is found in the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (90 Stat. 2776, 43 U.S.C. 1761) and in Title 43 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 2800.
