On May 2, 2005 I received two letters from you requesting a waiver from the monitoring requirements for storm water discharges in regards to each of the above referenced UPDES permits. In short, you waiver requests have been granted for the second year monitoring periods under Part I, Storm Water Requirements, Section E/F.5.a.(3)(c) of your UPDES permits. Please note that you will also need to submit similar waiver requests for the fourth year monitoring periods, provided the facility remains inactive and unstaffed for the duration of the UPDES permit cycles.
