PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West"), hereby submits responses to the deficiencies of the application for Phase I Bond Release of its Des Bee Dove Mine site. The application requests that Phase I Bond Release be approved for the reclaimed Phase 1 - Little Dove and Beehive Mines, Phase 2 - Deseret Mine/bathhouse/tipple and Pumphouse areas.

In addressing the said deficiencies, information concerning the reclamation of the Des Bee Dove Mine site has been added to Directive Number: Tech-006 (General Technical Requirements for Phased Bond Release). This entire document is included with this submittal and should replace the September 5, 2005 written document

Changes in the bond release request amount requires that Attachment B (Notification Letter), Attachment C (Public Notice), and Attachment D (Drawing 1) be amended. These attachments are included.

An additional Attachment E is included with this submittal. This Attachment holds the chemical soil analysis of the material below the reclaimed channel. Samples were taken at stations 1+00 through 8+00. These chemical analyses was not incorporated in the approved permit and are being included as part of the Phase I Bond Release application.

A Phase I Bond Release application for the two remaining sites (Sedimentation Pond and remote portals in Maple Gulch Canyon) will be filed in the near future. If there is any questions or concerns with the information provided herein, please feel free to contact Dennis Oakley at (435) 687-4825.


