Dana,

As a reminder, Des Bee Dove Mine sediment pond discharge is no longer a required monitoring site for DMR reporting. On February 3, 2006, a letter was sent to DEQ (Pete Hess/Jim Smith copied) notifying them that the pond had been reclaimed. On March 7th, DEQ (Jeff Studenka) and myself inspected this site. DEQ sent an inspection report (Pam Grubaugh-Littig copied) on March 9th indicating that the "site is now "inactive" therefore, DMR's will no longer need to be submitted, the SWPPP for the facility will no longer need to be maintained and no further site inspections will be necessary."

Please remove the requirements to report water quality data to the Division's database as of January 31, 2006.
