Subject: Conditional Approval of Reduce Permit Area Boundary, PacifiCorp, Des Bee Dove Mine, C/015/0017, Task ID #2795

Dear Mr. Fleck:

The above-referenced amendment is conditionally approved upon receipt of eight clean copies prepared for incorporation and the following information with a revised C1 and C2 forms.

- The Permittee must update all maps in the MRP that show the permit boundaries. Maps that show the permit boundary but were not included in the amendment include but are not limited to: 1-3, B.C. Seam, 2-12 Vegetation Map, 1-4 Hiawatha Seam and 1-5 Disturbed Area. The Permittee may want to consult with various Division staff members to determine which maps still need to have permit boundaries.
- Page 1-3 of the Legal Financial Volume was apparently revised to show a change of address for the Applicant, but a superseded page was used as the template. Thus, inadvertently, Douglas Johnson is being returned to resident agent status. Revised page 1-3 of the General Contents for the Legal Financial Volume should state that Kenneth Fleck is the registered agent for Energy West Mining Company (this change was incorporated in February 2007).
- Information in the Division files indicates that 2.52 acres associated with the pumphouse site and the reclaimed haul road received Phase III bond release on April 5, 2007. However, Note 1 of the revised Disturbed Area Reconciliation Table (Appendix G) states, "Originally the Phase 2 Reclamation Area contained 23.3 total disturbed acres. On April 5, 2007, the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining approved Phase III Bond Release on all acres of disturbed land within this area." The Permittee appears to indicate that 23.3 disturbed acres received Phase III bond release. Note 2 of the same table appears to state that only 0.9 acres received bond release at the pumphouse area. Both statements are incorrect.



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The Permittee must more clearly state that 2.52 acres associated with the pumphouse site and the reclaimed haul road received bond release on April 5, 2007.

- The legal description for the Des Bee Dove permit area in Appendix G has been inadvertently cut short by the table formatting, please revise to include the full legal description for Section 26.



In addition, I agreed to rescind the deficiency letter dated May 31, 2007 on the condition that all of the conditions set forth in this letter are complied with.

Please submit the required copies by July 20, 2007. Once we receive these copies, final approval will be granted, at which time you may proceed with your plans.

A stamped incorporated copy of the approved plans will also be returned to you at that time, for insertion into your copy of the Mining and Reclamation Plan. This modification does not necessitate an update to the Technical Analysis.
