Subject: Invitation to Attend Phase I Bond Release Inspection for Reclaimed Areas - Sediment Pond Area and the Remote Beehive Portal and Deseret Portal Breakouts, PacifiCorp, Des Bee Dove Mine, C/015/0017, Task ID #3043, Outgoing File

Dear Mr. Carter:

You are invited to attend the bond release inspection for the reclaimed areas at the Des Bee Dove Mine: the reclaimed sedimentation pond and access road and the remote Beehive Portal and Deseret Portal breakouts. The inspection will commence on October 16, 2008 at 2 p.m. at the reclaimed sedimentation pond.

The reclaimed pond area is located in Sections 35 and 36, T. 17 S., R. 7 E. It is adjacent to Des Bee Dove Crossover Road (the former Des Bee Dove coal haul road, now EC#412) that connects the Des Bee Dove Mine site with SR57. From Price, travel south on SR10 and turn west (right) on SR29. Proceed through Orangeville and at the junction with SR57, turn north-northwest onto SR57. Travel approximately 2 miles to another junction and turn right onto the paved EC#412, heading approximately north-northeast. The reclaimed sedimentation pond is on the east side of the road, approximately one mile from the junction and at the bottom of the large road-cut going up onto Danish Bench.

The reclaimed portals are in remote locations with steep terrain in Maple Gulch Canyon, in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T. 14 S., R. 7 E. There is no plan to visit the reclaimed remote portals as part of this Phase I bond release inspection, and no on-the-ground inspection of these sites will be scheduled unless a person having an interest specifies a need to do so. Photos of the reclaimed portals, taken from a helicopter, are available.


Total acreage proposed for Phase I bond release is approximately 13.9 acres. Reclamation of the 13.88-acre sedimentation pond and access road area was completed in January 2006. The Permittee completed reclamation of the remote portals, approximately 0.01 acre each, in July 2000.
