Dear Mr. Smith:

The Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) for the above mentioned mine has been review by this office. The sedimentation pond in question was constructed in 1979. Prior notification had not been given to the State Engineer, a violation of Section 73-5-12 of the Utah Code Annotated 1953. Those materials contained in Volumes 1, 2, 3, and 5 will satisfy the requirements of that section. An "as-constructed" copy of the construction plans is requested for our files.

The MRP indicates there is extensive use of the water encountered in the mine both above ground and in the mine. This use will require that Utah Power and Light make the appropriate water application with the Division of Water Rights.
