The above-mentioned mine operation was given a partial inspection on October 14, 1981. Larry Guymon of Emery Mining Company, accompanied the inspectors on the tour of the operation.

No compliance problems were observed. Inspectors discussed Emery Mining Company's plans for a retaining wall below the ROM conveyor required for slope stability and erosion control as a contemporaneous reclamation measure. Mr. Guymon informed inspectors that a budget had been allotted for the improvement but plans had not been developed.

Inspectors were informed of plans for a waste rock disposal site proposed for a site below the parking area across from the loadout pad. Plans for the waste disposal site were allegedly submitted to our Division but cannot be located. Mr. Chris Shingleton will be contacted in an effort to locate these plans.
