Dear Mr. Crawford:

Concerning your request regarding the Utah Power & Light Company's subsidence and groundwater monitoring programs, this information is available at the State Division of Oil, Gas and Mining. Dave Darby of the Division was contacted and he has offered to help you find the information you want in their offices. He and other contact persons at the Division may be contacted at 533-5771 in Salt Lake City and are as follows:

The Office of Surface Mining and the Division are reviewing the Utah Power & Light Company's permit application packages for the Deer Creek, Des-Bee-Dove and Wilberg mines under the Utah Coal Mining and Reclamation Permanent Program, revised as of September 20, 1982. A copy of these regulations is available from the Division.

As I indicated in my July 14, 1983 letter to you (copy enclosed) the Deer Creek and Wilberg permit applications have not yet been found to be complete. Upon our determination that these applications are complete, a notice will be published in the local newspapers as required under UMC 786.11(a). Following publication of the fourth weekly notice, you will have 30 days to comment.

Dear Mr. Crawford:

The Western Technical Center of OSM has begun a review of the Deer Creek and Wilberg mine permit applications. As indicated in his June 24, 1983 letter, Mr. Hagen of our Albuquerque New Mexico Field Office has provided us with several pieces of previous correspondence from you dating to May of 1981. To the extent possible, we will factor your concerns, as expressed in that previous correspondence, into our technical review. However, since our decision must be based on written documented findings, it is important that you advise us of any pertinent information which you believe to have been omitted from the permit application. You will have the opportunity to provide such information after the application has been determined to be complete by OSM and the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining. The notice of filing a complete plan will be published in the Emery County Progress and the Price Sun Advocate when the plan is determined to be complete.

I have enclosed a copy of Part 786 of the Utah regulatory program which pertains to public participation in the permitting process. The OSM review will be conducted under the Utah regulations.
