
To abate the subject violation issued January 13, modified February 18, and again on March 29, 1983, we are submitting responses which meet the remedial actions required.

Enclosed are drainage control plans of the transfer structure with answers to questions posed by the Division in their initial review. Also, drainage and sediment control plans for the conveyor belt (C-1, C-2) which we will implement. However, as we have previously advised you, it is the position of Utah Power & Light Company that the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining lacks jurisdiction over such conveyor belt system from the coal crusher at the mine to the Huntington Power Plant. We have not departed from that position and submittal of such plans should not be deemed to be a waiver of any rights the Company may have to challenge the Division's jurisdiction.

On approval of the transfer drainage plan, work will begin immediately. It is estimated that the project will require twenty-one (21) working days.
