This report is submitted as required by UMC 817.71. This report consists of the second and third quarterly reports.

Work on the site started around April 1st, 1984, this consisted of removal of the small storage shed and other associated structures. The foundation of the site was leveled, scarified and recompactd. No vegetation existed because of previous disturbances. All combustible material and trash was removed prior to any material placement.

During the construction all rocks larger than 2' in diameter were sorted from the fill and placed on the fill slope face.

During this construction period sources of the fill material have been trommel screen reject and excavation of the main west rock slope. Less than 10% by volume of this fill material is combustible.

As required the fill slopes are 2 H to 1 V.


Construction of the fill has been made using a D8K dozer. The fill thickness has been two feet or less as required by MSHA.

The surface drainage has been operated as designed with drainage away from the fill face. The active fill area is sloped to allow for water drainage to prevent ponding and subsequent saturation of the fill area.

Elevation of the active fill level as of October 5th, 1984, is approximately 7380'.00'.

This report is on file at or near the mine site as required.
