The resource recovery and protection plan (R₂P₂) or underground mining part of the subject PAP has been considered adequate for BLM administration of the associated Federal coal leases. Our memorandum dated February 6, 1984, stated that the R₂P₂ is compatible with 43 CFR 3482.1(c) rules and regulations, and that the proposed coal recovery procedures will safely obtain maximum recovery of the coal resource using current technology and available mining equipment.

On October 15, 1984, we received volume #6 and replacement maps and pages that were forwarded with your letter dated October 11, 1984. This information was identified as "10/01/84 submittal of revisions for mining and reclamation plan." We have reviewed volume #6 and the maps and pages received on October 15, 1984. We did not identify any conflicts with the R₂P₂ part of the subject PAP or with the future recovery of the coal resource within the plan area.

Within the limits of our authority we concur with the Des-Bee-Dove Mine R₂P₂ as amended and on file in this office. We recommend that the R₂P₂ be included as an integral part of the subject PAP.
