On June 22, 1984 a partial inspection of the Deer Creek Mine was conducted by Ken Wyatt and Tom Wright, Field Specialists for the Division. Mr. Larry Guymon accompanied these inspectors in the field. The purpose of the inspection was to examine for abatement work done in relation to Notice of Violation N84-7-4-1. The weather was clear and warm.

Riprap has been placed in the ditches on both sides of the Deer Creek Mine access road. Silt fences throughout this area have been replaced and appeared adequate at this time. Utah Power and Light should consider seeding these ditches and associated disturbed areas along the access road to help further stabilize and revegetate these areas.

Notice of Violation N84-7-4-1 was terminated following this inspection. No other compliance problems were encountered at this time.
