A partial inspection of the Deer Creek Mine was conducted by Sandy Pruitt accompanied by Val Payne on June 5, 1985.

Compliance at the mine site was very good. The pre-Act doghole into the cliff behind the trash bin next to the warehouse/shop remains open. The operator was in the process of constructing a larger tipple at the base of the waste rock disposal site. Since the last inspection, the drainage culverts under the upper mine yard had been cleared and are completely functional at this time. The trash rack over the inlet to the drain located near the southwest corner of the bathhouse was partially obstructed with sediment and needed maintenance.

No violations were warranted as a result of this inspection.
