The Deer Creek Mine site was inspected by Sandy Pruitt, DOGM, and Val Payne, Emery Mining Corporation on January 31, 1985. The mine was back in full production this week following a temporary shut-down since the Wilberg Mine fire in mid-December, 1984.

The entire mine area and conveyor line was inspected. No compliance problems were apparent. The Utah Division of Wildlife Resources had placed a camera at a point along the lower end of the conveyor to film deer crossings under low sections of the conveyor less than 45" inches in height. By recent tracks apparent in the snow, deer had crossed along the water bar under the conveyor in this area.
