RE: Amendment to Approved MRP Amendment - 8" Water Supply Line and 100,000 Gallon Storage Tank, Deer Creek Mine, Utah Power and Light Company, ACT/015/018-86B, Emery County, Utah

I visited the site on September 17, 1986 with Larry Guymon of Utah Power and Light Company. Any concerns regarding Deer Creek were looked at and it was determined that the operator had not disturbed the creek and was aware of the problem of disturbing the creek without the appropriate approval.

I have no problems with the current amendment and the operator was made aware of all appropriate sediment control measures to be implemented if necessary to protect Deer Creek. Mr. Guymon was also made aware of the consequences associated with disturbing any stream channel without the appropriate 93-R permit from the Division of Water Rights. He was told to contact Mr. Mark Page in Price if he had any questions regarding this 93-R permit and its requirements.
