The Division has completed the review of Utah Power & Light Company's revised plans (received July 31, 1986) for the new 100,000 gallon water storage tank and 8 inch water supply line for the Deer Creek mine. The operator has provided certified maps and reclamation cost estimates which address the Division's previous concerns. The plans are technically adequate and final approval is hereby granted by this Division to implement the MRP amendment.
