Our "Best Efforts" commitment on riprap gradation acknowledges that an ideal gradation would result in a smooth-size distribution curve although it is not practical. The commitment for filter blanket thickness is supported by information contained in the text, "Applied Hydrology and Sedimentology of Disturbed Areas", (Barfield, Warner and Haan, 1981) page 195.
