This letter is in response to your September 6, 1988 letter regarding the East Mountain subsidence monitoring program.


- ° During 1987 conventional ground surveys were not conducted on East Mountain. Aerial photogrammetric surveys were done however. The results of these surveys were submitted to the Division in June 1988 in the form of the "Subsidence Monitoring Program Annual Report for 1987". Information relating to monitoring points above Deer Creek 5th and 8th East, Wilberg 5th and 7th, and 10th - 13th Right panels are included in this report.
- ° Work is currently being conducted on the 1988 report. Both ground and aerial surveys are being done. This information will be submitted to the Division in the January/February 1989 time frame which will be in accordance with Special Condition #5.
- ° The terms and conditions for Special Condition #6 of the Wilberg/Cottonwood Mine will be met in the 1988 subsidence annual report. Both conventional ground and aerial surveys will be done. In addition, an amendment request to revise Condition #6 so that only aerial surveys be conducted has been submitted. The 1988 annual subsidence report, which will be submitted in early 1989,

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will also contain a request to discontinue monitoring in
certain areas of East Mountain.
