Re: Review of The Elk Canyon Storage Plan Submittal of 9/16/88, Deer Creek Mine, ACT/015/018-88(d), Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

Division staff have reviewed the above noted response to the Division's Conditional Approval letter of August 17, 1988. The plan is not in the format which allows it to be inserted into the approved Deer Creek Mine plan. Further, a cover letter indicates Utah Power and Light's desire to insert this information into the approved Deer Creek Waste Rock Mine plan.

This does not appear to be a logical location for the plan. The material submitted will need to be re-formatted to allow insertion into the approved Deer Creek Mine plan. It is recommended that the materials be inserted in a location at or near page 6-32 Volume 1, dealing with underground development waste. The pages and maps need to be numbered appropriately, for insertion into the Deer Creek PAP. Instructions for insertion of this material in the PAP should accompany your next submittal to assure there is no confusion for the Division or the parties who are keeping current copies of the Deer Creek Mine plan.
