Dear Walt:

In the meeting held in your office September 19, 1989 to clarify UP&L's monitoring in the North Rilda area UP&L committed to the following.

1. Establishing a permanent surface monitoring site in the left fork of Rilda Canyon located 2400 feet north and 2100 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 29, Township 16 South, Range 7 East. This site will be monitored for flow and field parameters monthly, access permitting.
2. Establishing a permanent surface monitoring site on the North Fork of the South Fork of Meetinghouse Canyon located 300 feet south and 450 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 6, Township 17 South, Range 7 East. This site will be monitored for flow and field parameters in conjunction with the recession springs in July through October, access permitting.
3. Spring 79-19 located 80 feet north and 940 feet east of the southwest corner of Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 7 East will be monitored in July and October annually for flow and quality.
4. In 1990 only measuring flow and field parameters in both the North and South forks of the South Fork of Meetinghouse Canyon located at 1150 feet north and 2000 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 4 and 10 feet north and 1550 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 7 East. These points will be monitored once in July and once in October to establish their relationship with the contributing springs.

We had previously agreed with the Utah State Division of Oil, Gas and Mining to add the monitoring of the following springs (flow and quality) in July and October annually.
