Time for abatement may be extended by authorized representative for good cause, if a request is made within a reasonable time before the end of abatement period.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. N 89-20-1-1

Violation No. 1 of 101

Nature of violation

Failure to operate in accordance with approved plan.
Conducting mining activities without prior approval from the Division.

Provisions of act, regulations or permit violated

UMC 771.19 and UMC 817.45 (Sediment Control)
U.C.A. 40-10-9 et. seq.

Portion of operation to which notice applies

Widening of access road (Emery County Road #3-04) within the permit area.

Remedial action required (including any interim steps)

1. Cease all activities related to the widening of the access (county) road within the permit area until ^{plan is} approved.
2. Temporary sediment controls must be implemented immediately.
3. Permanent sediment controls must be implemented upon completion of road construction.
4. An amendment must be submitted to the Division (see page 3)

Abatement time (including interim steps)

1. Immediate implementation of temporary sediment controls.
2. Implementation of permanent sediment controls immediately upon completion of construction.
3. Amendment to the approved plan must be submitted and approved prior to any further development of access (county) road within the permit area or NOVEMBER 15, 1989.
