Dear Ms. Littig:

Pursuant to Utah Coal Mining Rule R614-303-230.100, PacifiCorp Electric Operations (successor to Utah Power & Light Company) hereby notifies the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining of its intent to renew its mine permit at the Deer Creek Mine.

Transmitted herewith is current and updated information pertaining to the Deer Creek Mine P.A.P.

Included herein are 12 each complete new binders (Volumes 1-7) to replace the original binders of the P.A.P., together with revised replacement maps to be inserted into their respective packets. Volume 1 contains the written text material addressing Sections 1 (Legal) and 2 (Environment) and Volume 2 contains Sections 3 (Operations) and 4 (Reclamation). Both Volumes 1 and 2 have been completely retyped, pages renumbered and referenced to the new rewritten rules with the purpose of replacing the original P.A.P. Volumes 1 and 2 in their entirety. The remaining Volumes 3-7 should be utilized to house the remaining contents of the P.A.P. An organizational listing is provided, together with a new Table of Contents, to assist you in organizing the P.A.P. We will also make ourselves available to your office and the other agencies to insert and re-arrange the P.A.P. contents, so everyone is working with an updated and properly organized P.A.P.

Recent organizational changes within the Fuel Resources Department of PacifiCorp Electric Operations has now positioned the mine permitting activities under the direction of Mr. **Bart Hyita**, Managing Director of Technical Services. By virtue of this change, Mr. Hyita is the resident agent who will accept service of process for our mine permits. He is located at the above address and at phone number 220-4616.

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As you may already have been made aware, we have also made changes with the operator of the mines in Emery County, Utah. As of October 1, 1990, **Energy West Mining Company**, a wholly owned subsidiary of PacifiCorp, has replaced Utah Power & Light Company Mining Division as the operator of the Deer Creek, Cottonwood and Des-Bee-Dove Mines. The above changes are so noted in the submitted material.

It has been our pleasure to work with you and we've sincerely appreciated your continued assistance in our permitting needs.
