AUTOMATED SECURITY SYSTEM

Transmitted herewith please find seven (7) copies of the modification to Utah Power and Light Company's plan for amending the Deer Creek Mine Permit Application Package. The materials should be used to update the approved PAP as follows:

Replace Drawing CM-10546-DR, Packet 3-18, sheets 2 and 3 of 6, with same drawings revised 3/12/90.

The amendment modification involves installation of the security gate near the terminus of the county road. Drawing DS1208D depicting the installation site, is provided for your information. This installation will include widening of the mine access road and relocation of an existing drainage culvert (12" plastic pipe). The road widening will involve placement of approximately 3200 ft² of additional asphalt. All work will be done within an area previously affected by mining operations. Additional disturbance within the affected area is necessary to facilitate widening of the road.

Approximately 0.04 acres (2,000 ft²) of an area previously associated with the America Fuel Mine will be affected during construction of the approach to the access gate (see Drawing DS1208D).

Reclamation costs associated with removal of the gate installation and additional asphalt are estimated to be approximately \$4,000 which is approximately 0.2% of the total

reclamation bond. Therefore, no revisions have been made to the itemized reclamation cost schedules in the PAP.

It is requested that the Division's review of the proposed modification be completed by March 19, 1990. If you need additional information, please call Val Payne at 687-9821.
