Dear Ms. Littig:

Enclosed please find information regarding proposed amendments to the Deer Creek Mine Permit Application Package. Said amendments involve additions to the mine surface facilities. All of the projects are within the present disturbed area at the mine.

A storage dock is proposed for construction in the mine material yard. The location is indicated on the enclosed 8 1/2" x 11" portion of the Surface Yard Map (Drawing DS-202E, Packet 3-9). The dock will be constructed of approximately 150 yards of reinforced concrete. Open storage for roof bolts, wire mesh and roof mats will be provided by the dock. Reclamation costs are estimated to be approximately \$2500.

Also proposed for construction are two (2) Master Control Center (MCC) buildings at the locations shown on the enclosed 8 1/2" x 11" drawings.

A single 18' x 27' building, approximately 10' high, will be built near the existing tippie building. It will be constructed of aluminum framework with aluminum siding. The building will be placed on a reinforced concrete foundation with a concrete floor. The building will house the electrical controls for the tippie. Reclamation costs are estimated to be approximately \$6000.

A second MCC building is to be constructed near the C1/C2 conveyor transfer structure. An aluminum building approximately 12' x 12' x 8' high will be constructed on a concrete floor and foundation. The building will house the electrical controls for the conveyor

**transfer facility. Reclamation costs are estimated to be approximately \$2000.**

**The estimated reclamation costs for all projects total \$10,500; which is approximately 0.6 percent of the current Deer Creek Mine Reclamation Bond. Therefore, the itemized reclamation cost schedule in the PAP is not being revised.**

**It is requested that the Division's review of the proposed amendments be completed by November 27, 1991. Following Division approval and project construction, the appropriate PAP drawings will be revised and submitted to the Division for distribution.**
