

GENERAL PURPOSE RIDER

Deer Creek Mine  
Permit ACT/015/018

To be attached to and form part of Bond Number 9272158

effective December 6, 1990

issued by the American Casualty Company  
One Million Seven Hundred Twenty Four Thousand and No/100 in the amount of  
(\$1,724,000.00) DOLLARS, on behalf of PacifiCorp Electric Operations

as Principal and in favor of State of Utah, Division of Oil, Gas & Mining (Division) and  
the U.S. Department of Interior, Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSM) as obligee:

Now, Therefore, it is agreed that:

The following shall be added to the captioned bond at the end of paragraph five.

In the event the Cooperative Agreement between the DIVISION and OSM is terminated,  
then the portion of the bond covering the Federal Lands will be payable only  
to the United States, Department of Interior, Office of Surface Mining.

It is further understood and agreed that all other terms and conditions of this bond shall remain unchanged.
