The Division appreciates the information submitted September 27, 1991, regarding the portal sealing at the Deer Creek Mine. The Division was under the impression that the original plan was to use a helicopter to avoid any disturbance of the area. As mentioned in the letter, transportation of portal sealing materials will be coordinated with the maintenance activities to avoid unnecessary surface disturbance. However, it must be pointed out that this area has been disturbed and revegetated. Any areas that may need re-seeding should be re-seeded and will be reviewed at a regular inspection of the Deer Creek Mine site.
