Re: Response to Letter dated July 31, 1991, Citizen's
Complaint, PacifiCorp Electric Operations, Deer Creek
Mine, ACT/015/018, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

Your letter dated July 31, 1991, indicated that you have a water right allocation from the Cottonwood Spring in Cottonwood Canyon. You believe this spring may have been impacted by PacifiCorp Electric Operation's activities in the East Mountain vicinity. After examining the Mahogany Point 7.5 minute topographic map, this spring may be located in either Sections 13, 14, 23 or 24 in Township 17 South, Range 6 East, Salt Lake Base Meridian.

Without a field investigation, we cannot determine an exact location of this spring. Ken Wyatt, Reclamation Hydrologist with my staff, attempted to contact you on Thursday August 8, 1991, to arrange for a field tour of the area. We would like to visit this site early this week, possibly Tuesday or Wednesday, August 13th or 14th. I think it would be beneficial if representatives from PacifiCorp Electric Operations, the Utah Division of Water Rights, and the Cottonwood Creek Irrigation Company also attend this meeting.

Please call me at 538-5340, at your earliest convenience, so that we can arrange a convenient time for the site tour and coordinate this time with the other parties. We look forward to meeting with you regarding this issue.
