**RE: SLOPE STABILITY AND SURFACE SAFETY INSPECTION, PACIFICORP,  
DEER CREEK MINE, ACT/015/018, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH**

**Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:**

**For your information, on April 19, 1993 a surface safety and slope stability inspection was conducted by the Safety Department at the Deer Creek Mine in accordance with MSHA regulations.**

**Two sites were identified during this inspection where rock and rubble need to be removed to protect the facilities and the employees.**

**The first site is located by the main fan just above the drop inlet that drains the seep. A large boulder with extensive cracks needs to be removed to protect the fan structure. This boulder lies within the perimeter markers and disturbed area and will be removed and the area stabilized as necessary to protect the fan.**

**The second site is located on the first terrace above the ROM belt. Rock sluffage has occurred filling a portion of this terrace. No rock has come off the hillside toward the bathhouse at present date, but this sluffage allows a ramp for future sluffage to bypass the terrace and potentially damage the bathhouse. This area lies outside the perimeter markers on a pre-law disturbed area. This sluffage will be removed and the area stabilized as necessary to protect the bathhouse. As in the past, because of the nature of this area and the natural cause, no long term liability for the terrace area will be assumed and this area will remain as a pre-law disturbed site.**

**This work is scheduled to begin no later than June 1, 1993. Enclosed is a location map.**


