

**RE: EQUIPMENT STORAGE AREA AMENDMENT, PACIFICORP, DEER CREEK
 MINE, ACT/015/018, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH**

Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

When the sediment pond at Deer Creek mine is cleaned it becomes necessary to utilize a temporary sediment basin (see enclosed letter dated August 15, 1991).

PacifiCorp desires to use the temporary sediment basin area as an equipment storage area, when it's not being used as a sediment basin during sediment pond cleanings. The area would still be reclaimed during final reclamation but not contemporaneously after every sediment pond cleaning as it is now scheduled.

Drainage control for this area is handled by ASCA Area #1. Equipment storage will not alter the approved drainage control system.

Please find enclosed Pages 3-34 and 3-35 which have been revised to indicate this amendment and Plate 5-1, CM-10673-DR, which has been revised to show the location of the equipment storage area.
