PacifiCorp has proposed to drill up to five emergency coal exploration holes by helicopter on Federal coal lease U-06039 outside of an existing mine permit area. All of these holes will be drilled to define the limits of an area of burned coal that could possibly underlie a proposed surface facility in Rilda Canyon.
