2. **Signs and Markers**  
Perimeter markers have been placed to include the terrace above the mine site. The disturbed area around the explosive storage area was not adequately delineated. The operator indicated that he would have additional markers installed.
  
4. **Hydrologic Balance**
  - a. **Diversions**  
All diversions that were inspected were clear, dry and appeared to be functioning appropriately.
  
  - c. **Other Sediment Control Measures**  
All alternate sediment control structures that were inspected were in good repair and appeared to be functioning properly.
  
8. **Non Coal Waste**  
Some trash was observed in the parking lot. The operator was encouraged to keep the lot clean. Otherwise the site was clean and well ordered.
