1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

The amendment which has been submitted to allow the removal of the Trail Canyon sediment pond has been designated as 95-E. Review is pending at this time.

4a. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS

The permittee has installed additional riprap in the mouth of the ditch which directs the Trail Canyon access road runoff to Trail Creek.

4c. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES

The permittee has installed new filter fabric in the worn areas of the silt fence which is directly east of the Trail Creek stream buffer zone. Approval of the Trail Canyon Phase Two bond release submittal is still pending.
