#### 4. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE:

a. Diversions - The culvert inlet near the tire storage dock had been cleaned as requested in the previous inspection. Recent runoff from precipitation was observed and all observed drainages appeared to be functioning as designed. The culvert at the bottom of the snake road (water tank road), adjacent to the office building requires cleaning.

The undisturbed drainage through Deer Canyon was dry, the drainage through Deer Creek Canyon contained a large volume of runoff.

c. Other Sediment Control Measures - The area of previous concern where wind born coal fines had been deposited was clean. This area is adjacent to the conveyor, at the confluence of the sediment pond discharge culvert and undisturbed culvert into Deer Creek.

#### 7. COAL MINE WASTE/REFUSE PILES/IMPOUNDMENTS

Slopes on the refuse pile are to be reduced, this will be done prior to the next inspection.

#### 10. SLIDES AND OTHER DAMAGE

The drainage had been established behind the emergency berm.
