

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiaries, Interwest Mining Company ("Interwest") as managing agent and Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits an Operating Plan for Resistivity Surveys proposed to be conducted on East Mountain.

Recently, a faulted (graben) area has been encountered in the Deer Creek Mine Fifth and Sixth West Sections. The displacement is significant enough that additional information regarding the graben is imperative for mine planning purposes. The most immediate source for the needed information is resistivity surveying. Therefore, PacifiCorp proposes the accompanying Operating Plan to obtain the needed information.
