

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, herewith submit the As-Built drawing and the text pages that were shaded when submitted with the original amendment. The permit pages now have the shaded areas removed, the drawing has been revised on mylar and depicts the areas that need to have silt fence remain and the areas that will use vegetation cover as the primary means of erosion control. Only the Waste Rock Site access road has any changes to the ASCA.


