

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, herewith submits an amendment to revise Appendix XIV: 9th East Breakouts Reclamation Plan to reflect final reclamation completed in December, 1999. PacifiCorp initially submitted the 9th East Breakout Reclamation Plan on September 1, 1999 and received approval on September 21, 1999. Final reclamation activities commenced on November 8, 1999 and was completed on December 10, 1999. Approximately 0.6 of an acre was reclaimed during this project, including demolition and removal of the portal facilities.

To comply with the Division's amendment process, PacifiCorp has provided four (4) redline/strikeout copies each of the following (one copy has been sent to the Price Field Office):

Deer Creek Mine: Revised Permit Drawings




