Subject: Amendment to Revise Deer Creek Mine, Rilda Canyon Permit Drawings, PacifiCorp, Deer Creek Mine, [REDACTED], Emery County, Utah

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits an amendment to revise the maps CE10883EM, CE10884EM, and CE10891EM of the Deer Creek Mine MRP, volumes 5 and 6. These drawings are of the Rilda Canyon mine surface area and are being amended in coordination with the deficiencies received concerning the Deer Creek reclamation plan. The deficiencies (document dated November 6, 2000; Deer Creek Reclamation Plan & Vol. 9, PacifiCorp, Deer creek Mine, C/015/018-AM99C-3(&AM00D, Outgoing File)) requires Energy West to revise Rilda Canyon drawings to detail the disturb boundary, portals, and highwalls more clearly. }

This portion of the November 6 deficiencies is being handled separately so the changes can be incorporated into the Deer Creek MRP immediately without having to wait on the revised Deer Creek reclamation plan approval. Expeditious review of this amendment will assist in responding to deficiencies for the revised Deer Creek reclamation plan. Revisions to the maps are outlined below. }

Map CE10883EM, Volume 5, Deer Creek MRP

- Change appearance of disturbed boundary line.
- Illustrate location of highwall areas.
- Relocate disturbed boundary to reflect boundary changes on map CE10884EM.
- Illustrate the plan view cross-section stations

Map CE10884EM, Volume 6, Deer Creek MRP

- Change appearance of disturbed boundary line.
- Change appearance of outcrop representation
- Relocate the disturbed area boundary (North/South ripped channel) completely within the confines of the disturbance.


