Dear Mr. Semborski:

The Trust Lands Administration agrees to your proposed 2002 drilling program for the Mill Fork Coal Tract. I'm enclosing a copy of comments on your proposed operations that I received from the Utah Resource Development Coordinating Committee. Please heed the concerns of DWR regarding impacts upon wildlife in the area. Also, please be cognizant that no cultural resources surveys have been conducted in the area and of the requirement that no cultural resources be disturbed.

Please obtain all necessary surface-use and access permits from the Manti-La Sal National Forest and a coal exploration permit from the Division of Oil, Gas & Mining prior to commencing any operations upon the lands under ML 48258 in 2002. At the conclusion of drilling the bore holes must be plugged and the disturbed surface areas reclaimed in accordance with your plan of operations and any additional requirements of the surface owner and the Division. The Trust Lands Administration holds Surety Bond No. KC 6513 in the amount of \$50,000 to ensure reclamation.

I look forward to receiving a copy of all drill-logs and geological reports pertaining to the 2002 program at the conclusion of operations. Please contact me if you have any questions.
