Dear Mr. Blake:

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby submits two copies of the exploration data compiled from the "2004 Mill Fork/Joes Valley Drilling Program" (State Lease ML-48258), including lithologic logs, geophysical logs (compact disk), coal quality analysis and report of water observed. Drilling commenced on July 5, 2004 and was completed on August 12, 2004. A total of four holes were drilled detailing the geologic / hydrologic characteristics of coal reserves in State Lease ML-48258. The following summary outlines the drill hole information submitted along with the hole abandonment documentation:
