Dennis,

I think that your biologist probably already know this, but the south-facing cliffs that I refer to are not actually the face of the canyon walls, but rather side arm canyons that extend back from the south face. These side arms would probably be missed by the models.

These canyons provide cooler and more humid conditions than surrounding area; clumps or stringers of trees or canyon walls containing crevices, ledges, or caves; higher percent of ground litter and woody debris; and riparian or woody vegetation (although not at all sites).
